Noticeboard Policy

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for usage of the five Parish Council noticeboards and the material which can be displayed.

The noticeboards are provided to publish parish council information relating to the parishes of Great and Little Whelnetham and are the property of the parish council.

The noticeboards are currently located as follows:

- Main noticeboard outside the village shop
- Little Whelnetham next to the bus stop and post box
- Little Whelnetham on Water Lane
- Two on the Railway Walk

All noticeboards are locked

Anyone wishing to display a notice in the three noticeboards at the village shop, or on Little Whelnetham should in the first instance approach the Clerk to discuss the suitability of any item.

Great & Little Whelnetham Parish Council is unable to consider any item which is for a business venture.

Great and Little Whelnetham Parish Council will consider any item relevant to the local community and those detailing community-based charitable concerns.

The two noticeboards on the Railway Walk will display information specifically relevant to the Railway Walk, including information on appropriate footwear to wear, details of flora and fauna including photos and feature posters of historical information relating to the Railway Walk.
