**C685 Stanningfield Road, Great Whelnetham – Drainage Improvement Scheme  
November 2021 – March 2022**

We are writing to inform you of our plans to carry out a drainage improvement scheme on A134 Sudbury Road, Sicklesmere, C685 Stanningfield Road and Hambrook Close, Great Whelnetham. This is to alleviate the ongoing highway and property flooding in the area. The scheme is programmed to commence on Monday 8 November 2021 and will continue until 24 March 2022. Please note that there will be a two week break over the Christmas and New Year period. The works will be put on hold and the site will be left open and safe.

**Phase 1:** 8 November – 19 November – Temporary traffic signals will be placed on A134 Sudbury Road, as well as a road closure on C685 Stanningfield Road\*

**Phase 2:** 22 November - 17 December – A road closure will be in place on C685 Stanningfield Road, between the A134 junction and the Private Road\*

**Phase 3:** 4 January – 2 February – A road closure will be in place on C685 Stanningfield Road, between the Private Road and Raynsford Close\*

**Phase 4:** 3 February – 24 February – A road closure will be in place on C685 Stanningfield Road, between Raynsford Close and Hambrook Close\*

**Phase 5:** 25 February – 24 March - Access only road closure on Hambrook Close

\*The road closure of C685 Stanningfield Road, Great Whelnetham, to through traffic, will be in place for approx. 12 weeks. Access only to residents will be from either the junction with A134 Sudbury Road, Sicklesmere or from the junction with Great Whelnetham Primary School. For the duration of the road closure (24hrs), traffic will be diverted via A134, Chapel Road, Hoggard's Green, Bury Road, Stanningfield Road and vice versa.

Please be advised that the dates listed above are approximate and if we need to make major changes to our work dates, we will update the information signs on site.

Every effort will be made to keep noise and disruption to a minimum while this essential work is undertaken. Business and property access will be maintained; however, staff will be on site to advise you of the restrictions and arrangements at the point you require access or egress.
